Dear Members,

I am happy to share our Q2 newsletter with you. In the second quarter of 2022, our footprint in CFA Institute was further deepened through the recognition of our members. Two of our Society Leaders emerged winners in the Volunteer of the Year Category of the CFA Institute 2022 Society Excellence Awards. The award recipients are Sade Odunaiya, CFA and Banji Fehintola, CFA both past presidents of the Society.

Sade Odunaiya, the founding President of our society, won the global Lifetime Achievement Award. She was instrumental to the establishment of CFA Society Nigeria; under her leadership, the society sprouted and blossomed because of her leadership qualities, passion, and resilience. As a member of the pioneer board, she set the strategic direction for the Society. This award therefore recognizes her long-term contributions to promoting the CFA designation and ideals in Nigeria and Africa.

Banji Fehintola, the immediate past President, won the Volunteer of the Year Award, EMEA Region. Over the years, he has helped to develop and strengthen the Society. His vision enabled CFA Society Nigeria to grow candidate and affiliate membership, establish two CFA test centers in Lagos and Abuja, a society office in Lagos, grew participation in our annual Research and Ethics challenges, and secured multiple partnerships and sponsorships for the society amongst other things. Still within the quarter, Banji was nominated to serve on the CFA Institute Board of Governors.

On behalf of the Board of Governors, I wish to congratulate Sade and Banji, and thank all our volunteers for what you continue to do for the Society. These achievements are testimonials to the sterling contributions of our volunteers as they vividly demonstrate their commitment to actively supporting the mission of the Society and CFA Institute.

In furtherance of building/developing young professionals, we launched two Investment Clubs in Bowen and Covenant Universities respectively. The clubs are student-led and through them, we will extend our reach to universities within the country. The investment clubs will be key in implementing projects such as the annual Research and Ethics Challenge, Financial Literacy Outreaches, University Affiliation programs and Students Investment Conferences, etc.

We hosted our second Breakfast Knowledge Sharing Session; the session was focused on the Valuation of Fintech Companies. In deepening/expanding our presence on the

continent, we collaborated with CFA Society South Africa to host a webinar on the recent launch of the eNaira, Nigeria's Central Bank Digital Currency. In continuation of the Quarterly Leadership Series which has since grown in impact and reached 5,000+ registrants, 3,000 live attendees and about 21,700 views on YouTube, we hosted the 4th edition. We rounded off the quarter with a webinar on Risk Management: The Art of Hedging in Personal Finance hosted by the Gender Diversity Committee. All these events are CPD verifiable and are available for replay on our website's video gallery.

In line with our objective for establishing the Gender Diversity Committee, we awarded two more Gender Diversity Scholarships to women for the November 2022 exams. This is in addition to the ten awarded in January. The scholarships are funded by the Endowment Fund raised in 2018 and it covers 50% of the cost of the exams for the awardees. I would like to thank the Gender Diversity Committee for their excellent work on these initiatives. We are open for sponsorships to enable us give out more scholarships to deserving women seeking to build a career in the investment profession.

Given the progress recorded with the Gender Diversity Committee and our believe that many more people can benefit from the work they do, I am pleased to announce that our Gender Diversity Committee will now be known as the **Diversity and Inclusion Committee**. This is to reflect your Board's resolve to expand the scope of the committee beyond merely recognizing and acknowledging the diversity we have amongst us but to deliberately taking steps to give a sense of belonging and inclusion to those diversities which by the way are beyond only gender. The mandate of the committee will be recalibrated accordingly.

I am delighted to inform you that the Society shall be hosting our iconic Investment Conference on 6 & 7 October this year and it promises to be an event to look forward to. At the end of the event, we would also be celebrating our new charterholders that have earned the charter since 2020 but could not be celebrated due to the breakout of the global COVID 19 pandemic. Save the date, we will give you more updates as plans unfold.

As a reminder, our FY23 membership renewal campaign is ongoing, and we have over 100 renewals. Thank you to every member who has renewed their membership. I encourage those who are yet to do so to renew today as we look forward to meeting your career and professional development needs by bringing you educational resources, career events, networking opportunities, and more.

Finally, many thanks to our Governors, Volunteers, Members, Staff, Sponsors and Partners for another successful quarter. Please enjoy the newsletter.

On 3 May, CFA Society South Africa partnered with CFA Society Nigeria to host a webinar on the recent launch of the eNaira, Nigeria's Central Bank Digital Currency.

The panel discussion featured Lucia Okafor, Senior Manager, Payments/Digital Transformation at Strategy&, Fadele Adeolu, eNaira Project Manager, Central Bank of Nigeria, and Oluremi Tinuolu-Gabriel, Vice Chairman of the Committee of eBusiness Industry Heads (CeBIH). They discussed the rationale for creating the eNaira, its impact on the Nigerian economy and digital payments in Africa and its prospects as it continues to develop.






Webinar on **Risk Management:**The Art of Hedging in Personal Finance (1.5 PL Credits)

Our guest speaker, Funmi Adepoju, CFA, Managing Director of PearlMutual Consulting Limited spoke on the importance of risk management in personal financial planning in ensuring optimal returns, especially given rapidly changing economic dynamics. She also covered the impact of global economic trends & the current fragile state of the Nigerian economy on developing optimal hedging and diversification measures in personal finance.
